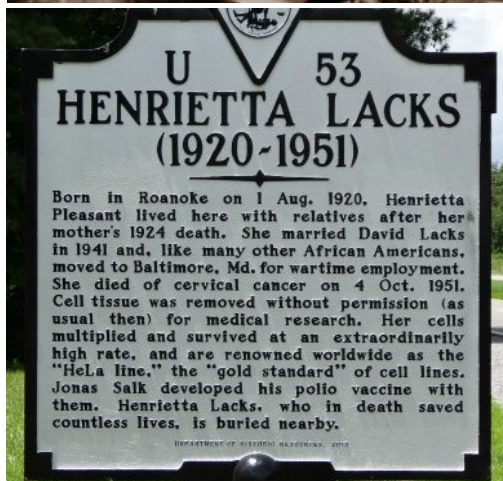

African American’s in Times of War

Pictured: The Fight of a “Cell” - Henrietta Lacks



Henrietta Lacks, 31-year old mother of five, died of cervical cancer in October of 1951. Prior to her passing, during a radiation treatment, doctors removed two cervical samples without Lacks consent. The samples were sent to researcher Dr. Geogre Otto Gey, in order to learn more about cervical cancer. Gey noticed unusual qualities of Lacks cells. He had been cloning cells for the purpose of research but the cells were not surviving. However, the cells of Lacks cervical sample multiplied exponentially and quickly.

By 1970, Lacks tumor cells, by this time named HeLa cells, had been cloned and sold to more than 100 for-profit laboratories around the world, all unknown to her family. It wasn't until 1973, a scientist reached out to the family seeking blood samples and other genetic material to gain more insight of cell composition, as the cell were so aggressive and killed other cells. Due to the nature, of how this was all explained, the family was under the impression that there was a number of cloned “Henrietta Lacks” living around the world. Of course that was not the case, in fact HeLa cells have been used to create vaccines, and treatment for other known virus and test anti-tumor medicines such as;

Salmonella treatment, HIV treatment, Gene mapping, Cancer treatments, HPV vaccine, Polio vaccines, AIDs research, toxicity research, to name a few. Since the initial cloning and distribution of HeLa cells in 1955, over ten thousand patents involving HeLa cell have been registered.
