Crenshaw Bl Restoration: What You Need to Know

What is restoration?

The Crenshaw/ LAX Transit Project has been actively under construction along Crenshaw Bl since January 2014. Over the past few years, major milestones have been achieved in tunnel completion and station excavation. As the Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project gets closer to opening day, fall of 2019, a final phase is necessary to restore the road over the three underground stations along Crenshaw Bl.

Restoration will require the removal of the concrete panels lining Crenshaw BI over each station box. Utilities currently hanging from beams will have to be permanently secured before the road sections are backfilled. Once temporary supports are removed and backfill is complete, the road will be repaved. The last phase of the restoration process will entail reconstruction of curbs, gutters, sidewalks and ADA ramps.

When will restoration occur?

The restoration of Crenshaw Bl is anticipated to begin in June 2018. Each phase of restoration will be implemented immediately following the other.

Where will restoration occur?

Restoration will begin at the three underground station areas along Crenshaw Bl. Work at each station will be performed separately as three phases in progression from south to north.

The first phase will implement a closure at the Leimert Park Station area and the at-grade transition section. This phase will require a closure of Crenshaw BI from 48th St to 43rd St/Homeland Dr. The closure for the first phase will last 43 days.

The second phase will implement a closure at the Martin Luther King Jr. Station area. This phase will require a full closure of Crenshaw BI from Stocker St to Martin Luther King Jr. BI. The closure for the second phase will last 23 days.

The third phase will implement a closure at the Expo/Crenshaw Station area. This phase will require a full closure of Crenshaw BI from Coliseum St to Exposition BI. The closure for the third phase will last 37 days.

WORK ALONG CRENSHAW BL IN THREE PHASES SCHEDULED TO BEGIN IN JUNE 2018

Phase 1: Leimert Park Station Restoration

- > 48th St to 43rd St/Homeland Dr
- > 43-day closure

Phase 2: Martin Luther King Station Restoration

- > Stocker St to Martin Luther King Jr. Bl
- > 23-day closure

Phase 3: Expo/Crenshaw Station Restoration

- > Coliseum St to Exposition Bl
- > 37-day closure


As part of the restoration closure operation, Traffic Control Officers (TCO) will be deployed at critical intersections to safely manage traffic conditions along the detour and alternate local access routes.

PHASE 1: LEIMERT PARK STATION RESTORATION - MID-JUNE TO LATE JULY



ESSENTIALS

- > During the first phase, a full closure of Crenshaw Bl will be implemented from 48th St to 43rd St/Homeland Dr.
- > The closure for restoration of the Leimert Park Station is scheduled to last 43 days.

DETOURS

> Northbound:

East on Slauson Av North on Western Av West on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl North on Crenshaw Bl

> Southbound:

East on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl South on Western Av West on Slauson Av South on Crenshaw Bl

NOTE

- > Local northbound access to Crenshaw businesses and residents will be available via Leimert Bl
- > Southbound traffic will be detoured at Martin Luther King Ir. Bl
- > Local traffic to Baldwin Hills Crenshaw Mall will have access via Martin Luther King Jr. Bl, Marlton Av, Santa Rosalia Dr and Stocker St
- > Eastbound and westbound through-traffic will be closed at Vernon Av

PHASE 2: MARTIN LUTHER KING STATION RESTORATION – LATE JULY TO LATE AUGUST



ESSENTIALS

- > During the second phase, a full closure of Crenshaw Bl will be implemented from Stocker St to Martin Luther King Jr. Bl.
- > The closure for restoration of the Martin Luther King Jr. Station is scheduled to last 23 days.

DETOURS

> Northbound:

East on Vernon Av North on Western Av West on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl North on Crenshaw Bl

> Southbound:

East on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl South on Western Av West on Vernon Av South on Crenshaw Bl

NOTE

- > Crenshaw BI between Vernon Av and Stocker St will be open to local access only
- > Local traffic to Baldwin Hills Crenshaw Mall will have access via Martin Luther King Jr. Bl, Marlton Av, Santa Rosalia Dr and Stocker St

PHASE 3: EXPO/CRENSHAW STATION RESTORATION - LATE AUGUST TO EARLY OCTOBER



ESSENTIALS

- > During the third phase, a full closure of Crenshaw Bl will be implemented from Coliseum St to Exposition Bl.
- > The closure for restoration of the Expo/Crenshaw Station is scheduled to last 37 days.

DETOURS

> Northbound #1:

East on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl North on Western Av West on Jefferson Bl North on Crenshaw Bl

> Northbound #2:

West on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl / Rodeo Rd North on La Brea Av East on Jefferson Bl North on Crenshaw Bl

> Southbound #1:

East on Jefferson Bl South on Western Av West on Martin Luther King Jr. Bl South on Crenshaw Bl

> Southbound #2:

West on Jefferson Bl South on La Brea Av East on Rodeo Rd / Martin Luther King Jr. Bl South on Crenshaw Bl

NOTE

- > Southbound traffic will be detoured at Jefferson Bl
- > Crenshaw BI between Exposition BI and Jefferson BI will be open to local access only



Project Overview

Metro's Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project will extend from the existing Metro Expo Line at Crenshaw and Exposition Boulevards in Los Angeles, and merge with the Metro Green Line at the Aviation/LAX Station on Aviation Bl and Interstate 105 in El Segundo. The line will travel 8.5 miles, serving the cities of Los Angeles, Inglewood and El Segundo.

Once in operation, the Crenshaw/LAX Line will offer alternative transportation options to congested roadways providing significant environmental benefits, economic development and employment opportunities throughout LA County. Riders will have easier connections within the Metro Rail system, municipal bus lines and other regional transportation services.

Full Northbound and Southbound Street Closure for Street Restoration

Crenshaw Bl between 48th St and 43rd St/Homeland Dr

Summary

As part of Metro's Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project, Walsh-Shea Corridor Constructors (WSCC) will be working on the restoration of Crenshaw Bl. Restoration will begin at the three underground station areas along Crenshaw Bl. Restoration activities include removal of concrete panels, permanent placement of utilities, backfill and road repaving. Work at each station will be performed separately as three phases in progression from south to north. A separate notification will be sent out for the other two phases prior to the commencement of the work.

The first phase will implement a closure at the Leimert Park Station area. This phase will require the closure of Crenshaw Bl between 48th St and 43rd St/Homeland Dr.

Essentials

WHAT: Full northbound and southbound street closure for restoration **WHEN:** Starting 9pm June 15, 2018 through 11:59pm July 27, 2018.

Weather permitting.

WHERE: Crenshaw Bl between 48th St and 43rd St/Homeland Dr

DURATION: 43 days

What to Expect

Northbound detour:

- East on Slauson Av
- North on Western Av
- West on Martin Luther King Jr Bl
- North on Crenshaw Bl

Southbound detour:

- East on Martin Luther King Jr Bl
- South on Western Av
- West on Slauson Av
- South on Crenshaw Bl

Vernon Av will be closed for through eastbound and westbound traffic.

Traffic Control Officers will be deployed at critical locations throughout the detour route.

Access to emergency responders will be maintained.

La restauración comenzará en las tres áreas de la estación de metro a lo largo de del bulevar Crenshaw. Las actividades de restauración incluyen la eliminación de paneles de concreto, la colocación permanente de servicios públicos, el relleno y la repavimentación de la calle. El trabajo en cada estación se realizará por separado como tres fases en progresión de sur a norte. Se enviará una notificación por separado para las otras dos fases antes del comienzo del trabajo.
