

With President Dr. Ervin Seamster at the helm, Southwestern Christian College is engaged in a major fund-raising effort, and the direct impact of this \$250,000 campaign will be used to renovate the campus library. Because of a major leak in the roof and damage to computers and materials, the library is currently closed; however, a temporary location has been established.

During the renovation of the library, there is a secret plan to create a permanent Recognition Scroll to be placed in the library to honor Maybelline for her leadership and for her work to fortify the campus' buildings and grounds. Maybelline has been a staunch supporter of Southwestern Christian College for decades, and when she became a board member, she hit the ground running faster.

As a freshman board member, she pitched the idea of Adopt-a-Project and with the help of sisters across the nation, thousands of dollars were raised to renovate the girls' and boys' dorms; install plumbing, wiring, and lighting in the dorms and auditorium; install a security system; replace/upgrade fixtures, bathrooms, and laundry rooms; upgrade the air conditioning, just to name a few improvements.

Adopt-a-Project was clear and ambitious and has been a "marquee fund-raising project" for the campus. This national campus improvement project has been co-chaired by Doris Dansby.

As SWCC donors and supporters, we are an integral part of the team. Without us nothing could be accomplished. We, along with Maybelline, continue to pour out our heart and soul into reimagining our campus, which is almost 60 years old—and showing its age.






