HEALTH TIPS

TO DECREASE SPREAD OF FLU OR OTHER VIRUSES

Stay at home if you or a family member is experiencing cold or flu symptoms. If you suspect or actually become exposed to the Coronavirus, isolate yourself and notify your doctor for further instructions. Separate your self from persons who are sick. Avoid sharing drinks with your family from same drinking utensil. Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with your hands. Cover mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing with tissues when possible.

TIPS TO PREVENT SPREAD OF BACTERIA AND VIRUSES FROM ONE PERSON TO ANOTHER AT HOME AND AT CHURCH

Good and Frequent Hand Washing

- Wash hands after coughing, sneezing and handling of secretions from nose and mouth, using disposable tissues. Avoid use of handkerchiefs for secretions.
- Wash hands with soap and warm water using friction for 15 to 30 secs.
- Dry hands using dry disposable towel and use towel to cut off faucet and to open the door to exit the room.
- Use alcohol based gels and wipes to cleanse surfaces to fight spread of germs.

Avoid Holding Hands During Prayers

- Our hands are one of most common vehicles for spread of bacteria and viruses.

Avoid Greeting at Church With Hugs and Cheek or Forehead Kisses

- Hugs and kisses may be ways of spread of disease from the skin and by secretions (droplets) from the mouth.

Avoid Greeting With Hand Shakes

Greetings Crenshaw Church of Christ,

As each day passes, we continue to see an increase in COVID-19 cases in Southern California. This virus is highly-contagious and it can be especially threatening to those who fall into high risk categories of having compromised immune systems, those over the age of 60, those with heart disease, lung disease, diabetes or cancer. This week, Governor Gavin Newsom called for all gatherings of 250 people or more to be canceled across the State of California until the first week of April or until circumstances dictate otherwise.

In an effort to keep our members safe, we found it necessary to make certain changes to our worship services. Therefore, please see below for guidance regarding worship services effective Sunday, March 15th through Sunday, April 5th:

- **8am worship service**
 - We ask members who fall into the high-risk categories mentioned above and those that have families with elementary and younger children to stay home and participate in worship service on-line.
 - Out of an abundance of caution, we also strongly encourage all other members that do not fall into those categories to participate in worship service on-line as well.
 - Any members that arrive to the building will not be turned away and a live 8am worship service will be held.

- **Sunday morning Bible Study** – Will be postponed through April 5th or until circumstances dictate otherwise.

- **11am worship service**
 - We ask members who fall into the high-risk categories mentioned above and those that have families with elementary and younger children to stay home and participate in our 11am worship service on-line.
 - Out of an abundance of caution, we also strongly encourage all other members that do not fall into those categories to participate in 11am worship service on-line as well.
 - Any members that arrive to the building will not be turned away and a live 11am worship service will be held.

- **5pm worship service** – Will be postponed until April 5th or until circumstances dictate otherwise.
- **Tuesday morning Bible Study** – Will be postponed until April 7th or until circumstances dictate otherwise.
- **Wednesday evening Bible Study** – Will be postponed until April 1st or until circumstances dictate otherwise.
