

Jo has been in Stephen Ministry for 16 years. She has served as a Stephen Minister, is a Stephen Ministry Leader and is the senior trainer for the 50 hours of training all Stephen Ministers are required to take before they can be commissioned.

Jo has also served in the Handicapable Min-

istry, was on the Missions Team and worked with Hospice. In her early years, she was a missionary nurse in South America. After coming back to the states, she married her husband, Carlos; had three children: Bonnie, Tyler and Clayton and recently moved into a new home in Seminole. Jo has taught Bible studies and served with the Harvard Medical School Nurses' Health study. Her interests are in reading and physical fitness.


Students Are On Their Mission Trip This Week

Helping Children Follow Jesus

Some children may want to know more about making Jesus part of their lives. If you sense that someone might like to know more about following Jesus, you can use this simple explanation:

God loves us so much that he sent his Son, Jesus, to die on the cross for us. Jesus died and took the punishment for all the wrong things we do. But Jesus is stronger than death, and he came back to life! Jesus wants to be our friend forever. If we ask



our forever friend, Jesus will always be with us and will help us make the right choices. If we believe in Jesus and ask **him to forgive us, someday we'll live with him Forever in heaven.**

You may want to lead the child in a simple prayer inviting Jesus to be part of his or her life. You may also want to share one or more of the following scripture passages with the child.
