Days 11-15

DAY 11

SCRIPTURE READING

Now many Samaritans from that town believed in Him because of the report of the woman who testified, “He told me everything I ever did.” —John 4:7-26, 39 (NET)

Read the full passage: John 4:4-42 (NET)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Ask the Lord how you can engage others, even out of your own need, in such a way that opens them to conversations about Jesus.
- Pray that you would have prophetic discernment into the lives of those you engage.

DAY 12

SCRIPTURE READING

“I will give you peace in the land, and you will be able to sleep with no cause for fear. I will rid the land of wild animals and keep your enemies out of your land.” —Lev. 26:6 (NLT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

Dear Father God, Thank you for your mercies every day. It is so easy for us humans to harbor anger and resentment against others. I am so glad that you are not that way. Please help us to remember who we are and to see ourselves as you see us. Please help us to keep our focus on you and on improving our own faults, attitudes, and issues. I pray for those who are burdened with feelings of anger, distrust, jealousy, unfair treatment...things that will eat at their souls...that you will release that burden and free them from it. I praise you and thank you.

DAY 13

SCRIPTURE READING

And that’s the way it was with us before Christ came. We were like children; we were slaves to the basic spiritual principles of this world. But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children. And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, “Abba, Father.” Now you are no longer a slave but God’s own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir.

– Gal 4: 3-7 (NLT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Pray that you will always remember that you are not a slave to fear you are a child of God redeemed.
- Carry out Abba Daddy Father God I am in You and You are in me.

DAY 14

SCRIPTURE READING

SCRIPTURE READING

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Dear Lord, help us to fulfil your prayer. God breathe on us oneness to glorify your name and win the world over to Your kingdom.
