If you are new to Community, you may have wondered about the insert in our church bulletin two weeks ago. Every March, according to our church by-laws, we hold a meeting for the members of our church for the purpose of approving the men who have been nominated to be an elder. Elders at Community serve a 3 year term of office. That will happen at the close of all 3 worship services in the last 3 minutes on Sun, Mar 12.

Elders at Community do what we see elders doing in the NT Church; they are leaders and are responsible for the leadership of the church family. Elders in the Bible are also seen serving shoulder to shoulder with the apostles in setting direction for the church in its policy [Acts 15]. There are a number of charges addressed to the local church eldership about the spiritual care and shepherding of the flock of God. Flock BTW - was Jesus favorite term for the church.

You can read about the life and characteristics of an elder in 1 Timothy 3, as well as Titus 1. One verse that stands out about the responsibility of an elder is Titus 1:9 – **He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.**

I have long held that serving as an elder in the local church is much like serving on the local board. There is plenty to do and few will ever thank you for all the things that you do. I hope we at 3C will take the time to tell those who lead and serve us thank you for their service and commitment to Christ.

This past year Scott Wedemeyer has served as the elder chair, along with our other elders: Chris Clark, George Pindell, Frank Renn and Bob Turner. George is our lone elder whose term of service is up in April and he has decided to take a year off.

If you confirm them our current elders will be joined by John Fultz, Steve Guenther, and Dave Price. Dave and John have been off the eldership for a year while Steve will be coming on board for the first time. All of these men have called Community their home church and have served with their families for a number of years. I trust you will remember to pray for them, as well as offer them encouragement from time to time.
