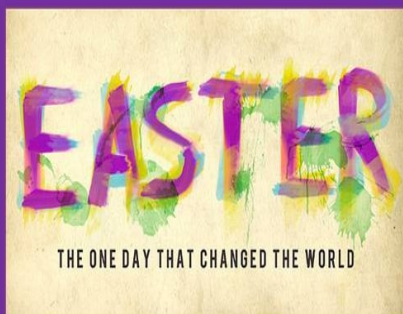

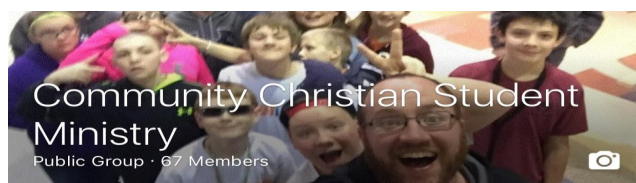

Sunday, April 9. At 12:30pm we will once again have our Easter Egg Hunt. (Many thanks to all of you for candy and stuffing the eggs.) It is a good day for kids. Lori divides the children up into various age brackets for those children birth – 5th grade. We do that to protect small children from older kids and grandma's who want to make sure their grandchild has the most eggs. Volunteer help is always needed to corral kids, keep children away from the street, and help with the bounce house, snow cones, giant slide or hot dogs.

Saturday, April 15. Our traditional tax-day will be our time to clean up around the building and help Miss Minnie get ready for Easter morning the next day. We will begin at 9am and wrap-up before noon.

Saturday, May 6. If you have thought that one day have a draw up a will please join us that morning. We, at 3C, will be hosting Financial Planning Ministry from 10am-Noon. FPM is a non-profit ministry. They sell nothing but will give you lots of free information and help in setting up your estate to pass on to your family and heirs, as well as helping the Kingdom to expand and grow through a family trust.
