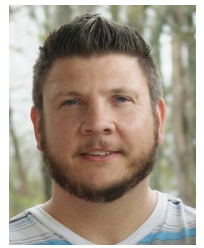

Pray for their travel safety, as well as the Word of the Lord to penetrate and enlarge the hearts of our young people.

We also will have our people serving with Lori at Woodland Lakes with the Special Needs Camp. We have a large number of our elementary children heading to KIDJam Camp as well July 9-13 in Indiana. Camp traditionally plays a huge role in the spiritual development of so many of us believers so do pray for God's Spirit to work powerfully through the various speakers and quiet times as the children open God's Word.

Last thing I would ask you to pray for is our teachers and sponsors who serve so faithfully in guiding both adults and young people in their walk with Christ. As we begin to think fall program around Community we will want to remember our small groups leaders as they, too, help others grow in the knowledge of God's Word. Thanks for serving and praying for our church and her mission to reach people for Christ.
