

Over the last two years many of you have been giving to our DIG Campaign to help "dig" us out of debt on the State Route 125 property. As I announced this past Sunday, with the sale of the north property (28 acres) and your giving the past two years, our indebtedness is now below one hundred thousand dollars.

We started DIG the first Sunday of June 2016; in basically 26 months we have reduced our debt from \$500,000 to now just under \$100,000. I know we all anticipate next year on Memorial Day Sunday, when DIG officially ends, that we will be debt free.

It can happen and we believe it will if we stay committed to praying and believing in the mission in front of us. The real mission is for us to be the church God has called us to be!

We seek to be a local church where lost people find Christ. Where people have support and encouragement when they go through hard or dark days/seasons in their life. In the days to come we will face many decisions about how to use the property, how large of a building we will build, or will we build in stages? This might be dictated by how much we think we can afford to spend or how much we wish to step out in faith? How much of a sports program can we staff with our volunteers? Are we going to be a church with small groups or a church of small groups? Our people will raise all sorts of questions. That's good, as long as we remember our real purpose and our mission is to reach people for Christ. Programs reach some people. However, it's our people, not our programs, that impact people and change lives.

We need, as a church, to commit ourselves to praying, reading and hiding God's Word away in our hearts - via Memorizing scriptures, we need to daily seek God's will for how we can best reach our community for Christ. We don't need to copy some other church but we need to think and ask for Godly wisdom on how to best reach our community.
