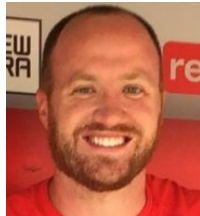

Last night I sat in with Nicole and her 2 volunteers for better than 20 plus kids for the Wednesday Night Elementary Program. Nicole at the start fed the kids, then told them about the Christmas (yes, Christmas) mission project they would be starting next week. Seems they are going to be decorating shoeboxes, then our kids the next week will be going to a store where they will buy the items (they suggested items that Nicole wrote on the whiteboard) and then they will pack the items along with notes for the kids who will receive the boxes in another country. Seems like a nice thing for kids to do, right? I think so. I have loved the Shoe Box project that Franklin Graham began years ago in an effort to reach out to people around the world with the message of Christ.

As I was standing outside watching the kids chase around on the grass (taking away some of that energy before we brought them back inside) a few minutes later I asked myself, "How is it we, as a local church, reach out to our world of Bethel and Clermont County with the message of Jesus?"

I quickly came up with a list of outreach events like our Hotdog/Water give away at the Homecoming Parade, the Bonfire at camp on Oct 21, the Christmas Parade, and for many of you Christmas Eve, which is a great night to reach out to our community, the Superbowl Boxes that we took to the Fire/Police Departments, Dessert Night in February, the concert on Palm Sunday evening, the many times we have gone out to support Empower Youth at the Burke Park, the Soup Kitchen twice a month, our VBS or MAD camp every summer, the corner water give away, and I know there are more. Yet, the greatest outreach I think is what every follower of Christ does day by day with their life. We demonstrate the love of Christ to those around us.

BTW – Nicole could use 2 or 3 more volunteers on Wednesday night. I also noticed our 2 & 3's group had only one adult, as does our 4 & 5's group. Really, we need more volunteers in a number of Children and Student areas. Could you help? Would you be willing to get involved with some young people to demonstrate how we adults reach-out to others in the name of Christ?
