

In 2004 before many of us called 3C our home and family, the leaders purchased 50 acres of land with the hope of one day selling the north 28 acres to help finance a new house of worship for the church family on the south 22 acres of land. BTW – we do still own the south 22 acres, just to avoid any confusion.

The timing of God as we celebrated our 2nd anniversary of the DIG campaign was incredible to me. Just as God orchestrated the events of Bethlehem or the events at Calvary – I believe fully that God orchestrated the events in selling those 28 acres of land.

Why the lesson in our recent church history? To let you know that God is active, alive, and involved with our church family. As Jesus told the ten lepers to go show themselves to the priest, they were healed and made whole as they went! Jesus worked with them, as they demonstrated their faith as they went. Mark, along with our Worship Ministry, had a wonderful Christmas Eve service for you: kids singing, Mark and Kami's special, the kids video, the praise band and vocalists - all done so well to worship the Christ child of Bethlehem.

The sad note about Christmas Eve was my decision to make the announcement about Leah Turner's passing. Leah passed unexpectedly in her sleep about 2:30pm on Christmas Eve. She and Bob have been a great example of a caring, Christ-like couple. She will be missed by many of us.

Our Christmas offering to Shonnie doubled through a matching fund donor. As we stretch to reach our Christmas offering goal of \$8,000 our offering stands at \$7,914.
