Please use your own judgement if you are medically vulnerable and/or elderly. You will be able to continue watching our FaceBook Live or YouTube Channel worship as usual at 11:15am.

- *No restrooms available
- *Do not get out of your car
- *Prepackaged communion in a ziplock bag
[prepared the week before] will be passed out as you enter
- * Offering bucket available as you exit.

This Sunday May 3rd I, for one, am happy to be able to meet at the Starlite Drive-In. We were asked by Anthony, the manager, to enter at 11am so our service can begin at 11:30am. Living the Word congregation has generally exited the drive-in by 11am (with the exception of a few set up/tear down people).

When you enter off HW 125 you will need to **stay in your car**. You will see a few people out of their cars such as those involved in setting up for the service, the safety team, and a few people with signage or communion supplies. We hope to have a 35-40 minute worship time. Your car will need to face the pickup trucks we will be using for a platform, on the east side of the Concession Stand. **Note** - communion has been prepackaged 6 days in advance and will be available for pick up in multiples of one or two to a bag, as you enter the drive-in.

Also Note - there are no restroom facilities.

As you exit you will notice several 5 gallon buckets hanging on speaker poles at the end of aisles. If you wish to leave an offering just pull up and drop it in the bucket as you exit. Your car radio will be your FM speaker. You control the volume. Do remember not to run your car battery down. Most car radios will run close to 10 minutes after you shut off your engine, so you will most likely need to restart your engine a time or two. You will certainly want to do so.

The staff has begun to talk about reopening the church building. That will happen - but not now! When we do reopen, it will be different as you can guess, chairs will be farther apart, rows of chairs will be farther apart, my guess is for a while we will have no children's areas - so all of us will be in the Worship Center and most likely the balcony.

This is being written early Friday morning and Logan Cover is having surgery at Children's Hospital in Cincinnati today. Do remember Logan and her family in your prayer time. Also, beginning May 6th, it's National Nurses Week so please remember to thank those who serve us so well. Also, thank you to Ken Cannon for mowing our west property.

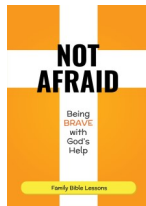

This week I am attending a digital ministry conference. I am looking forward to finding new ways to connect with all of you.

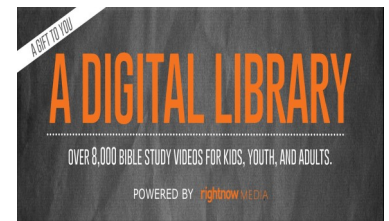
