### I Made a Mistake

Ever happened to you? Years ago I was sharing the stage with Lori Conly as we were given an opportunity to talk about our respective ministries. I said a statement I now regret. “I believe it is important for parents to bring their students to church even by force if need be.” Then I said, “I think it’s important to “push” them towards student ministry.” I wish I didn’t say that. I think it is equally as important for students to be involved with student ministry as I do with our church body. Corporate worship is important AS IS involvement in Christian community.
