- 2. After 40 days and 40 nights of going without eating, Jesus was hungry.
- 3. The tempter came to him. He said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."
- 4. Jesus answered, "It is written, 'Man doesn't live only on bread. He also lives on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" (Deuteronomy 8:3)
- 5. Then the devil took Jesus to the holy city. He had him stand on the highest point of the temple.
- 6. "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. It is written,
  - "The Lord will command his angels to take good care of you.

They will lift you up in their hands.

Then you won't trip over a stone." (Psalm 91:11,12)

- 7. Jesus answered him, "It is also written, 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'" (Deuteronomy 6:16)
- 8. Finally, the devil took Jesus to a very high mountain. He showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory.
- 9. "If you bow down and worship me," he said, "I will give you all of this."
- 10. Jesus said to him, "Get away from me, Satan! It is written, 'Worship the Lord your God. He is the only one you should serve.'" (Deuteronomy 6:13)
- 11. Then the devil left Jesus. Angels came and took care of him.
