- 2. "My lords," he said, "please come to my house. You can wash your feet and spend the night here. Then you can go on your way early in the morning."

No," they answered. "We'll spend the night in the street."

- 3. But Lot wouldn't give up. So they went with him and entered his house. He prepared a meal for them. He baked bread without using yeast. And they ate.
- 15. The sun was coming up. So the angels tried to get Lot to leave. They said, "Hurry up! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here. Get out! If you don't, you will be swept away when the city is punished."
