- Restored by Christ to give life abundantly
- Life zoe absolute fullness of life
- Different from chayay (ha-yi) to be quickened; to live (old testament)
- John 3:16
 - Eternal life doesn't mean time or condition but means supply
- John 10:10
 - o Came for life
- John 14:6

 The way, and the truth, and life
- 1 John 5:12
 - Have Son (Word) have life never thirst again

CONNECTING TO THE LIFE

- Romans 6:23
 - Wages of sin; free gift of eternal life
- Galatians 6:8
 - Sow /reap flesh; sow spirit reap life
- Reflect on spirit (life) in us (bubbling spring within John 4:14) or the flesh
 - Lack or provision
 - Not knowing or wisdom
 - o Sick or healing
 - Confusion or order
 - $\circ \quad \text{Sadness or joy} \quad$
 - War or peace
- John 15:1-3
 - Jesus true vine; no fruit God takes away (airo <i ro>- to raise up from ground); clean (free from corruption) because of the word
 - Not cut from the vine

USING THE LIFE

- 2 Peter 1:2-3
 - Through divine power of God life is granted
- Mind must understand (renew) that we live FROM God not FOR God
- When you live from the source it becomes easier to live for
- Holiness (Godliness) is a fruit not a root
- We are connected (it's in us) to external source
