PreSchool Camp-Child Care Department 2018 Summer Preschool Camp

Program runs June 11th-August 31st. The month of May will consist of 4-5 nightly trainings along with an open house. Staff are required to attend all trainings and be at the open house. At the open house, parents and children will get to meet the staff and see what a typical day of PreSchool Camp looks like.

The Oshkosh YMCA Child Care Department is seeking outgoing, responsible, caring, and dedicated staff to work in our summer Preschool Camp program for children ages 4 and 5. We are seeking individuals with availability Monday-Friday between the hours of 6AM-6PM

Day to day activities include:

Arts and crafts, group games, swimming, swim lessons, free choice, team building, character developments and weekly fieldtrips.

Full time staff-40 hours.

3 credits in education or children development or the 15 hour Department approved self-study course (can complete upon hire).
