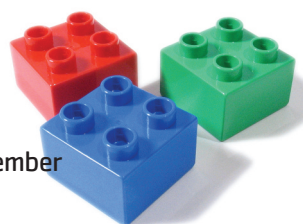

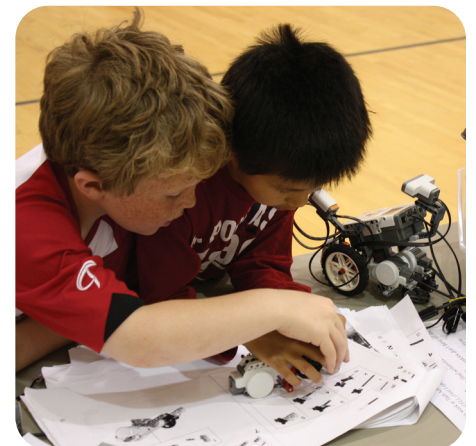
NATURE'S FURY 2013 FLL CHALLENGE
