

The Real Night Before Christmas

Tick tock, tick tock, tick tock. The tricky clock tick tocking Each painfully long minute unlocking the tumbley jumbley can't close your eyes feeling What will it be? When will it be? Oh the anticipation, the watching, the wishing, and waiting To let the wiggles and giggles and goose-bumps go. To find, to see to finally know What will it be? When will it be? Oh the expectation! The what if's, the oh my's fairly shaking Longing for this night's joy all year; That moment of hope so very near Oh but would they, could they, imagine a gift so great? A gift that compelled the whole world to wait When a Heavenly Father gave all mankind; His Son, the One, Love defined The magic of Christmas is more brilliant, you see, Than a bag or a box tucked under a tree The true love of Christmas really began, When Holy God became wholly Man

Read Isaiah 9:2 and John 1:9-14

Ask your children:

- What are you anticipating this Christmas?
- What do you think people were anticipating Jesus to be like before He came?
- Christmas is all about anticipating. Anticipating gifts isn't a bad thing, but is that all that we are looking forward to?
- What do you think heaven is going to be like? Are you looking forward to Jesus coming back to earth and taking His followers to heaven? That's what the Bible teaches us.

Jesus told his disciples that no one would know the time of His return, only God the Father. They lived the rest of their lives expecting Jesus to return any day. Do you think they would have lived differently if they knew that we would still be waiting 2000 years later?!

• If you lived anticipating Jesus to come back any day...with the same excitement you have about Christmas...how would it change the way you live?

Our life is all about anticipating Jesus return. Just like we are looking forward to Christmas, Jesus has something even more exciting than gifts under a tree. He offers us the gift of eternal life! **That is why Christmas matters.** Jesus came the first time to make a way for us to know God and to be made right with Him. Our sins are forgiven and our debt for sin has been paid. Jesus paid the price by dying in our place on the cross and conquered sin and death by rising from the grave! **That is the Hope of Christmas!**
