## What Joseph's Understanding About God's Sovereignty teaches us:

- His timing
- <u>Surrendered</u> lives
   Proverbs 21:1
   \*Trusting in God's sovereignty doesn't <u>license</u> my <u>sin</u>
- Faith not fear
- <u>Forgiveness</u> led to <u>fruitfulness</u> *Genesis 41:51-52*

## God Doesn't Need My Plans

- The biggest problem I have with God's sovereignty is me James 4:6
- God's best may not always <u>seem</u> to be what's <u>best</u> for <u>me</u> *Genesis 45:5-8; Philippians 1:12*
- God always <u>turns</u> things <u>around</u> Genesis 48:14
