WORDS FROM PASTOR JOHN

Sunday, June 4th will mark the beginning of the 48th session of The West Ohio Annual Conference. The Laity Session will begin at 5:30PM, and at 7:29PM Bishop Palmer will convene the 2017 Annual Conference. Annual Conference is held at Lakeside, Ohio on the shores of Lake Erie. Representing St. Andrew this year are our Lay Delegate Mr. Paul Bales, and our Pastor, Rev. John Schlicher. Also attending from St. Andrew is Mrs. Jane Henry as a Delegate at Large from the Miami Valley District. The conference is scheduled to conclude on Wednesday, June 7th at 4:30PM. Each day is filled with sessions beginning as early at 8:00AM, and into the evening as late as 9:00PM.

Highlights of the conference include our special times of worship together: The Opening Worship Memorial Service with Communion, the Celebration of Ministry Worship Service, and the Worship Service with Missionary Commissioning. We will have the Annual Laity Address, the Episcopal Address, and the Fixing of Appointments. There will be many other reports received, proposals made, and special recognitions. At this time, I believe that during the Fixing of Appointments I will be re-appointed to St. Andrew to begin my 10th year of ministry with you. As you know appointments are made on a year-to-year basis so we never know for certain when a call may come.

Traditionally clergy and churches are aware of any coming changes by the first of the year, or early in the New Year. Michelle and I are so very thankful for God's call on our lives to serve alongside of you in this season, and we look forward to the coming ministry year.

Something unique occurring during the Monday afternoon session of Annual Conference is Bishop Palmer and myself having a conversation. The unique part is that it's going to be on stage, in front of the entire Annual Conference. As I have moved back into some of my district responsibilities, I became aware that many people wanted to talk a bit about our experiences in Fort Lauderdale. Almost always colleagues and friends would share with me about how they prayed for us in the minutes, hours, days and months following those horrific events. It is overwhelming to understand the extent of prayers that were and are being offered for us and the many victims of the shooting. I learned of churches that called together special prayer services for us, and those involved. It wasn't just in West Ohio, the story made national headlines as well and was distributed to tens of thousands of United Methodist churches around the world.

It was shortly after that when it struck me that while I was at conference quite likely many people would be engaging me. I thought if I could publicly express my gratitude and thanks to everyone for their prayers and support it might be a good thing. Thus the opportunity to talk with Bishop Palmer and field a few questions was created. We don't know the exact time that this will take place, however we do know that it will occur on Monday afternoon during the regular session.




