6. How can enjoying our resources honor God?
7. Have you settled the ownership question? If so, what helped you with this? If not, what is hindering you?
8. What does it mean that we can only give God what comes from His hand?
9. What, if anything, have you done to pass on these lessons to the generation following you?
10. Are you realistic about the length of your days left on earth? Explain.
11. What is one thing you will do different as a result of this message?
