After discovering that there are 16,000 homeless kids in San Diego County schools, Bill and wife Sue created Got Your Back San Diego under the American Relief Organization, a 501(c)(3) non-profit. Got Your Back San Diego is a weekend food assistance program for kids identified as homeless under the McKinney-Vento Act.

GET TO KNOW JOE YOUNG

In 2012, Oceanside Police Lieutenant, Joe Young, planned on retiring after 30 years of service. One week before retiring, he was reading the newspaper and saw an article about a program to help feed hungry children in our local schools. He saw the need, and soon his retirement was really just from his job, but not from his desire to serve others. Two days before his last day at the Police Department, he came to check out the warehouse in Oceanside that is the office, collection and distribution center of Got Your Back San Diego.



Joe knew that he wanted to be involved in a behind-the-scenes way. Within a month of retirement, he was delivering backpacks to schools involved in the program. He was also communicating with school liaisons, coordinating other volunteers, and helping the organization to facilitate this valuable, much needed program to help hungry children. Joe also owns a UPS Store in Vista with his wife, and plans to expand this to several more stores. He has been a valuable asset to American Relief Organization and the Got Your Back SD program, helping to fill the hungry stomachs of children each week for the last three years.

HELPING FAMILIES AT OUR SCHOOLS

"GYB came to our school about two years ago and it has been a blessing to our families. The moment I signed up to have the program in our school, I knew our students would benefit, and I was not wrong. Every Friday, the 18 participating students are happy to come and pick up their backpacks and, on Monday, turn their backpacks in to my office without any reminders. I am happy that at least those students will be able to have food for the weekend. One family in particular comes to



mind. It is a mother with 5 children. She has been homeless and currently is in a program that is helping her keep a roof over their heads. Even with all of the struggles, she has managed to keep afloat. With this program, the kids do not go hungry during the weekend. This makes me very happy.
