

Confessions of Blessings for Your Children

Psalm 127:3–6 Lo, children are a heritage of the Lord, and the fruit of the womb is his reward. As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man so are children of the youth. Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them; they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.

Psalm 139:13–14 For thou hast possessed my reins; thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are thy works, and that my soul knoweth right well. My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

Joel 2:28–29 And it shall come to pass afterwards, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

Mark 10:13–14 And they brought young children to Him, that He should touch them, and his disciples rebuked those that brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not; for of such is the kingdom of Heaven.

Matthew 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, that in Heaven their angels do always behold the face of the Father which is in Heaven.

Matthew 18:1–3 At the same time came the disciples unto

Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven? And Jesus called a little child unto Him, and set him in the midst of them. And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 18:6 But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believeth in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Deuteronomy 6:6–11 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart. And thou shalt diligently teach them unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the post of thy house and thy gates. And it shall be when the Lord thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he swore unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not. And houses full of all good things, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full.

Genesis:17:7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Isaiah 54:13 All of my children are taught of the Lord, and great is their peace.

Isaiah 8:18 Behold, I and the children whom the Lord hath given me are for signs and wonders.

Psalms 115:13–14 He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children.

Isaiah 59:21 As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the Lord. My Spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the Lord, from henceforth and forever.

Isaiah 44:3–4 For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground; I will pour my Spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring. And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses.

Proverbs 11:21 The seed of the righteous shall be delivered.

Psalms 112:1–2 Praise ye the Lord. Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord, that delighteth greatly in His commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon the earth; the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Psalms 113:9 He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and

to be the joyful mother of children. Praise ye the Lord.

Isaiah 61:9 And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people; all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the Lord hath blessed.

Deuteronomy 28:4 Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body.

Joshua 24:15 But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the Lord our God; but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of the law.

Psalms 22:10 I was cast upon thee from the womb; thou art my God from my mother's belly.

Psalms 128:3 Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house; thy children like olive plants round about thy table.

Proverbs 1:8 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother.

Proverbs 17:6 Children's children are the crown of old men; and the glory of children are their fathers.

Acts 2:38–39 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy

Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

Acts 16:31 Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved and thy house.

Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother; that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

Ephesians 6:1–4 Children, obey your parents in the Lord for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. And ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath; but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou has known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:5 When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother, Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

3 John 1:4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.
