


- ⁹ Our only goal is to please GOD whether we live here or there,
- ¹⁰ because we must all stand before Christ to be judged. Each of us will receive what we should get—good or bad—for the things we did in the earthly body.












Love GOD First







Love GOD First (page 2)



How do I please GOD?

Point 1: **Be Courageous (Have Confidence)** vs.6a "6 So we always have courage. □ Courage – to possess mental or moral strength to venture, persevere and withstand danger, fear or difficulty; bravery, fearlessness, guts \Box Confidence – to be full of conviction; having or showing assurance and self-reliance





GOD reminds us that HE is our Protection. Isaiah 54:17 NCV, "17 So no weapon that is used against you will defeat you. You will show that those who speak against you are wrong. These are the good things MY servants receive. Their victory comes from ME," says The LORD." **Psalms 23:1,4 NKJV**, "The LORD is My Shepherd; I shall not want. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For YOU are with me; YOUR rod and YOUR staff, they comfort me.

□ Vs. 6 So we always have courage.





Point 3 (cont.): Be Focused (Have Goals) *1 Thessalonians 2:4 NCV*, "⁴ But we speak the Good News because GOD tested us and trusted us to do it. When we speak, we are not trying to please people, but GOD, WHO tests our hearts.

Hebrews 11:6 NCV, "⁶ Without faith no one can please GOD. Anyone who comes to GOD must believe that HE is real and that HE rewards those who truly want to find HIM."
