**“HEART FOR THE HOUSE”
PART II**

*“Then arose up the chief of the fathers of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests with all them whose spirit God raised to go up to build the house of the Lord which is **Jerusalem.**” - Ezra 1:5*

The book of Ezra is a glimpse into the history of Israel following their return to their homeland after being exiled for 75 years. Returning to Jerusalem was overwhelming as the city lay in ruin and disrepair. Upon arrival, one of their main priorities was to build the house of the Lord.

Ezra and the Israelites had a heart for the house. **They realized God's House was more than a physical building; it was a spiritual building.** Having a heart for the house is about building people's lives, marriages, families, and relationships. It is building a place of refuge, a hospital for the sick, and a sanctuary for the tired, worn, and weary. It is building a lighthouse to the world, a place where God's love, encouragement, and peace are evident.

To have a heart for the house we must :

- Be a People Whose Heart God Has Moved
Although a huge undertaking, God moved upon the leaders of Israel to rebuild the temple. Their work was orchestrated and directed by God. The Israelites were committed and dedicated to take action. **God's moving on the heart is more than a warm, fuzzy feeling you have following a Sunday service or hearing your favorite song. God's moving results in a commitment and an action to do.** Similarly, God has moved upon Life Church to seek after Him wholeheartedly with passion and fervency.
- Be a Holy People
Having a heart for God's House is about pursuing holiness. In Ezra, the priest were called to be holy. Peter said, **“You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God.” As priests we are to be holy because God is holy and He calls us to be holy.** A heart of

His house will be a heart that desires holiness and righteousness.

- Give Our Best
Ezra 2 says the people gave of their abilities unto the treasures of the work. They gave according to their ability. They gave in the building of the House of the Lord because they had a heart for His House. God did not need their gifts, but as a part of their faith and obedience, they gave. Having a heart for the house is not about being the best, but it is about doing our best.

Ezra valued the House of the Lord as he led the Israelites in the rebuilding of the temple. Likewise, as we embrace biblical core values, these values **will guide and direct Life Church into God's plan and purpose.**

There are seven non- negotiable core values I will focus on during our Sunday morning services We must be a church that is:

- Presence Driven: *We aspire to be purpose driven by the dynamic power of the Holy Spirit.*
- People Matter: *People matter to God and us.*
- Give All: *We serve because Christ modeled servant hood.*
- Healthy Relationships: *We strive to have healthy marriages, children, families, and a congregation.*
- Future Generation: *We intentionally embrace effective change to reach future generations.*
- Growth and Influence: *We want to continue to grow to influence our community.*
- Every Day Life: *We are committed to deepening the character and attitude of Jesus in every day life.*

I look forward to sharing these core values with your as they are interwoven into the fabric of our church's DNA. **Let us endeavor to be a House that seeks after the Lord and one that God is pleased with.**
