“WHAT GOD EXPECTS FROM YOU FOR YOUR COUNTRY”

“When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; but when the wicked beareth rule the people mourn.” Proverbs 29:2

From the moment the first settlers came to America and dedicated the land to “the glory of God and the propagation of the Christian faith,” the church played a central role in shaping the government structure of our nation. With the upcoming elections and our nation in a time of uncertainty, God is looking for the church to be the moral compass in directing our nation toward Him. Here are several biblical principles to follow in bringing about God’s blessing on our nation.

- *Be a Godly Influence*
Believers are to influence the world around them. **Jesus told us to be “salt of the earth and the light of the world.” We are to season those around us and illuminate the path of righteousness just as light does a physical pathway. We can be salt and light by fulfilling our civic responsibilities by paying taxes and voting.**
- *Pray for Your Governmental Leaders*
Whether you vote for a candidate or not, it is our responsibility to pray for those God has placed over us. The Bible says this is good and acceptable in the sight of God. If there was ever a day our governmental leaders need prayer, it is today! The uncertainty of our day and the morals of our society necessitate God’s people to fervently stand in the gap for those who lead and serve.

- *Respect and Obey Governmental Leaders*
In Romans 13, Paul told the Romans, “Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities... [W]hoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God...” This is an admonition from God as He established authority. Without government and laws, our society would be in chaos; therefore, it is imperative we respect and obey our laws.

- *Elect to Office Those Who Uphold and Mirror Righteousness*

It is your Christian responsibility to know what each candidate stands for and his political platform. As voters, we must be informed. Endeavor not to allow media bias to influence your decision. Be an informed voter and make sure the candidate of your choice upholds Godly morals and values - values such as the sanctity of marriage, the value of human life, and integrity and honesty.

The Bible describes leadership as being a sacred trust and placing a person in a position is a serious matter. We should never take our civic responsibilities for granted, nor should we look at it as a burden. It is our privilege to be able to be used by God to shape the values and morals of our nation.

- *Live Your Life So That God Will Bless You and Our Nation*

We should never fall into the trap of substituting political involvement for the Gospel. We must recognize that politics can never be an instrument of salvation. We can and should work for positive **change in our world. As you know, a nation’s problems are always spiritual in nature. As you live a Godly life before others, God will bless you and He will bless our nations as our churches actively pray and seek God on behalf of our nation. As we repent and pray, God will change us and bring healing to our land. The psalmist said, “Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, and the people whom He hath chosen for His own inheritance.” Let us do our part to see God change American. Real eternal change can only come through God! Until then, let us continue. . .**
