**“LIVING LIKE JESUS”**

*“Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, that no longer should live the rest of his time for the lusts of men, but for the will of God”- 1 Peter 4:1-2*

The Apostle Peter exhorts believers to have the mind of Christ so that when they suffer it will help **them accomplish God's will. With God's help, we can use suffering to our advantage.** Instead of becoming the victim of suffering, we can become the masters of our suffering as Jesus did. Through suffering we encounter, we are able to glean from them that:

• Suffering Can Be An Educator

The literal meaning of “educate” is to call forth. Adversity and hardship may be used to call forth powers and abilities that have been lying dormant. In the 18th century, Marie Antoinette with her frivolous, extravagant living helped bring on the French Revolution. But the terror of the revolution brought about a change in her. She said, “Tribulation first makes one realize what one is.” Of her it has been said, “She who lived like a fool came to her end like a queen.” Many people allow suffering to choke off and stifle the inner strength that they possess naturally or that God has given them. If it is we who decide by the way we use the suffering whether we come forth shining life gold or as a coward soft and yellow as an egg yolk.

• Suffering Can Be A Corrector

Sometimes people get false ideas about God and His love. One such false notion is that those who are righteous and honest will always prosper materially. This is not true because in some parts

of the world righteous people go to bed hungry every night. Another false idea that some Christians have is that in the end life will always be just and fair. Was life just to Jesus? When suffering strikes, we should not complain that life has been unfair to us, but by the grace of God we can be like the courageous souls of the Bible who serve God in spite of suffering.

• Suffering Can Be A Softener

Some people are righteous and good in every way, but they appear to be cold and calloused. Suffering helps soften the spirit in order to sympathize with others who are having trouble. Difficult times can help break up the fallow ground and bring tears into our eyes. It can help us be sympathetic to others who are suffering.

• Suffering Can Be A Revealer

In the midst of suffering, if we will look to Jesus. He will show us the resources that are available to us. The Holy Spirit will whisper to us that God loves us and wants to sustain us in our times of **trial. Remember Elisha's servant? It was only when the Lord opened his eyes that he saw the host of God surrounding the city.** (II Kings 6:17) Look to Jesus as He is the author and finisher of our faith.

Until then, let us continue. . .

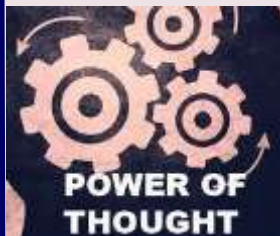
### **Encounter Prayer Service**
