#### **MOMENT'S REFLECTION**

Below is a visual illustration of how your ministerial staff would like to work with you to do effective Christian ministry.


The diagram is the product of much thoughtful discussion among ministerial staff and Executive Committee members over a several month period. The version you see represents a final draft. The diagram shows three main columns listing various ministry planning entities of the church. To the left of each column, in a blue box, is the name of one of your ministers, indicating that this ministerial staff person will serve as your primary resource and contact person. A little below each of the three top columns is another column indicating those areas where our Office Administrative Assistant, Brenda Keel, will assume primary planning coordination. Further down you'll notice another box with the heading "General Pastoral Roles." That box is connected to each of the ministers indicating that these responsibilities will be shared.

The diagram is guided by an important core value of minister to member partnership, not oversight. Names of ministerial staff are purposely placed alongside various ministries to signify a desire to enter into covenantal partnership. We envision our leadership role as one of shared ministry in contrast to a more hierarchal corporate business model. Naturally, there are some aspects of ministry planning that your ministerial staff has had formal training in performing. We encourage you to take advantage of our trained insight. Yet we also value your gifts and call to serve in the Church's ministry.

I think it's also important to note while I assume the role as primary preacher and as staff person who will primarily respond to pastoral needs through the week, this ministry will be shared with both Casey and Allison. I plan, for instance, to schedule Casey and Allison to preach once a quarter. I love preaching, but I also believe it's important that you hear the Gospel preached from a variety of perspectives. I also believe it's important that Casey and Allison have a chance to preach the Word and share in the worship life of our church.

How you can use this diagram? Ministry chairs are asked to direct their resourcing needs to the designated minister (or staff person). Ministry chairs are also asked to actively initiate reciprocal communication with designated staff persons regarding meetings and program plans. Members are also asked to direct program specific questions to the designated staff person.

As your Senior Minister, I appreciate your gifts and passion to serve our church. I speak for the staff in saying that we look forward to working alongside you in the coming year! —Dan



#### Christian Senior Helpers Ministry Successful Service Saturday



#### NEW PASTORAL CARE PHONE NUMBER

A new dedicated phone number has been set up at FCCG for use in contacting a minister with your pastoral concerns. If you have a pastoral concern, you may now call the new dedicated Pastoral Concerns number above, leave a message, and one of the ministers will get in touch with you. This is a monitored line, which will allow the ministers to quickly be advised of your call.

## FCCG KITCHEN RULES

For the continued safety and well-being of all church members and guests it is important to have guidelines in place for our communal-use kitchen refrigerator and freezer.

#### Guidelines:

- \* Please check all food for expiration date status before using. If in doubt, throw away.
- \* Do not leave open containers of juice or food in the refrigerator
- \* Take leftover juice/food/etc home or throw it away
- \* Properly Label Your Food
  - -- When you purchase food and store it in the refrigerator for later use, *label* your food with your name and Ministry
- -- Condiments are typically used by multiple Ministries so when you OPEN a condiment PLEASE label it with the Opened Date and an expected Expiration Date
- -- After your event, if you feel another Ministry (or your own Ministry) will use the leftover food BEFORE IT EXPIRES use airtight containers to store the food and *label* the container with your name and Ministry, what the food is, the date the food was placed in the refrigerator/freezer, the date the food needs to be thrown away and who the leftover food is designated to use. See below for a Label Example.

As part of an on-going effort, Fellowship Ministry is working on cleaning out the refrigerator and freezer. Expired or unidentified food will be thrown

away. Other food items will be labeled with an opened date and an expiration date for the item to be thrown away.

For your convenience a new message board has been added to the front of the refrigerator. If you see that we are low on a pantry item, please make note of this on the message board. There are also sticky labels for you to use when labeling you food.
