Meet at **Westlake Skating Rink** after Sunday School. Pizza will be provided!

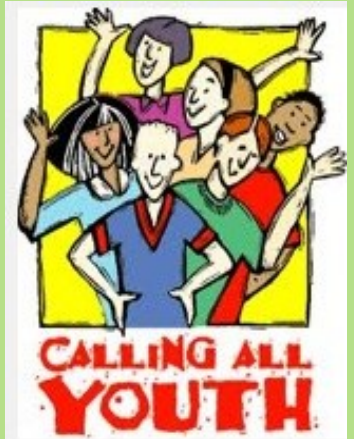

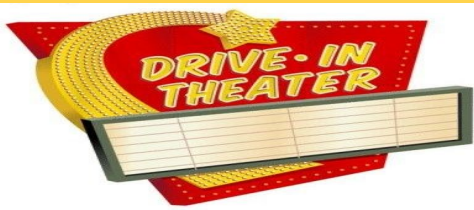
