Black sharpies

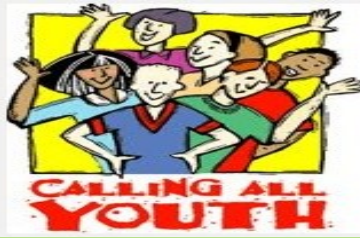

A basket of ready-to-go socks is currently kept in the narthex of the church. You are welcome to take a pair to pass along to others that may need an little extra reminder that they are loved.

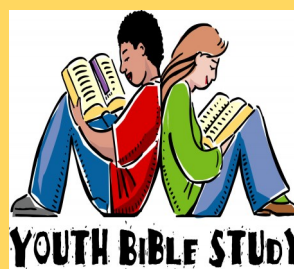

What is a Fusion small group? A group of about 6-14 people that meet regularly to share life, a yummy meal and prayer with one another. The focus is not on accomplishing a set agenda or extensive bible study, rather emphasis will be placed on building relationships and sharing holy moments.
