Search & Call Processes at Work

The Book of Acts describes a moment in the early church, following Jesus' resurrection, when the first disciples were tasked with choosing a replacement for Judas (Acts 1:21-26). Writer says that after prayer, the community "cast lots" to help them choose between two candidates.

I like that our early ancestors prayed. I don't advocate that we "cast lots." Instead, I ask you support a process of search and call based on a time-honored practice of discernment. Discernment is a spiritual



discipline of preparing oneself to listen to and hear the directing counsel of God. In discernment, we do our homework (prepare job descriptions, take stock of our church finances, write a church profile, meet together to deliberate, review resumes, and interview). But in all our work we strike a posture of discernment: we listen for God to speak to us about our ministry and how a candidate's gifts and graces for ministry might serve our church's ministry needs.

The Search Committees named below, are working to search and call our church's next members of the ministerial staff. We have entrusted them with important, sacred work. As they do their work, I (and they) will covet knowing that:

- You honor the process of search and call.
- You pray for the members of the committee to receive God's counsel.
- You send us candidates that have the gifts and graces we need.

I believe that the living Christ is prepared to help us in this work of search and call. I believe that the living Christ is already working in the hearts of those whom we will call. I believe we will experience joy and blessing in the months ahead. I believe our Church has an excellent future. -Dr. Dan
