RUSK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP CONCERT FEBRUARY 23

Once again this year, we will host the Rusk Family Memorial service on Sunday, February 23rd at 10:00am. This year's concert is titled "In This Hour" and will feature the music of Heather Sorenson an internationally known composer, arranger, and songwriter. Initially recognized for her skill as a pianist, she is now widely known for her choral, piano, and orchestral works. Heather has performed multiple times at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, and Constitution Hall, and her works are performed regularly at competitions, concerts, recitals, and churches worldwide.

Diversity is the characteristic that makes Heather somewhat of an anomaly in the industry: she easily maneuvers both the traditional and contemporary genres of Christian music, often combining the two for a unique blend that has become her artistic fingerprint. Attendees will hear our Chancel Choir perform several of Sorenson's pieces during the concert.

In addition to the musical event, First Christian Church Garland will also award the annual Rusk Memorial Scholarship to two lucky Garland ISD high school seniors. To qualify for the scholarship, students must be a GISD band, choir, orchestra, or art student in the top 25% of their class. They will also have to declare a music major when they attend college in the fall. Each recipient will receive \$1,000 for the 2020-2021 academic year, and must maintain a 3.0 grade point average while enrolled in at least 12 hours of coursework.

We hope you can attend to witness the talent of our Chancel Choir and the growing talent of our local Garland ISD students. **Make sure you are aware of the change in the service time—the Rusk Service begins at 10:00am.**
