SUNDAY, OCTOBER 18th

As defined by its sponsor, the Children's Defense Fund, the *National Observance of Children's Sabbaths Celebration* is a way for faith communities to celebrate children as sacred gifts of the Divine, and provides the opportunity for houses of worship to renew and live out their moral responsibility to care, protect and advocate for all children.

This celebration is a part of a broader children's movement that aims to unite communities and religious congregations of all faiths across the nation in shared concern for children and a

common commitment to improving their lives and working for justice on their behalf. In that respect, each action is bigger, more powerful and more inspiring than the efforts of any one celebration

As you have surely witnessed on the news and through the various sources of media, many parts of the world are in the midst of turmoil and unrest. This has led to a refugee crises across our nation. As these crises' continue, there is a great need and a wonderful opportunity for us to be the Church by helping to fulfill some of the most basic needs of families and children that find themselves in the midst of this chaos.

The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) has been requested to resettle 8% of ALL refugees who enter the U.S. thru Church World Service offices. Disciples have assisted in resettling more than 40,000 refugees through Church World Service since the end of World War II. To do that, we partner with our 34 CWS refugee affiliate offices all around the U.S. Dallas, TX is one of the locations of the CWS refugee resettlement offices.

Disciples have especially worked recently with refugee's cultures from Iraq, Burma, Afghanistan, Somalia, Bhutan, Syria, and the Congo. Most of these refugees are seeking safety, security and asylum from violence, war, persecution and extreme poverty.

This year, in celebration of Children's Sabbath, we are providing a simple and tangible way for you to help some of these refugee children and families in need.

In celebration of Children's Sabbath and in coordination with Disciples Home Missions, we will be collecting items for Hospitality School Kits. These kits will be provided to the numerous refugee children that are seeking to find some semblance of normalcy as they are integrated into schools after their arrival.

Please bring your school kit donations with you to worship on Sunday October 18^{th.} There will be a time to present your donations during the Children's Sermon in worship. The following items should be new. We will accept donations in bulk or put together in kits as suggested below:



-Backpack -2 notebooks -100 sheets paper -2 bottles glue -2 packages crayons -2 pair scissors -4 pencils, 4 pens


