




Successful programs begin with an understanding of the church's finances, which must be strong. The strength of our finances depends on our support of the 2021 Operating Fund which is budgeted at \$930,000 and remains unchanged from 2020. Ensuring the strength of our ministries, missions, and facility must be at the forefront of our coming together. Like the potter creating the vessel, we must begin with the right materials, center our clay, and apply just the right amount of pressure to our work. This work requires commitment. As Pastor Keeny recently mused, "Sacrifice is to give up something so that someone else receives the blessing" and "as we think of what we may sacrifice, it is worth thinking of the recipient of our sacrifice." During this season let us come together for transformation through our generosity.

## How King Avenue "keeps the lights burning bright"

Two-thirds of our expenses are for the people in the trenches doing ministry. 18% is for keeping the building running and 20% is for direct ministry.
