Sunday | August 21 | MOVIE NIGHT 6:00 pm in the Auditorium

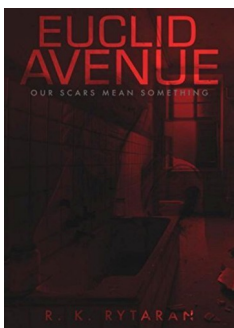
