Getting Started

Can you think of a time when you were first (either in order or rank)?

Take a moment and read Colossians 1:15-20 Was there one thing that stuck out to you about Jesus being first in this reading? It could be a question, or something that bothers you. Write down that initial impression and take a moment to talk to Jesus about it.

What does Colossians 2:20 say about Jesus being the head?

What does this verse help us understand about being part of the body with Jesus as the head?

What do you think it means for the church (that's you and me) to put Jesus first?

What happens if we lose connection with the head, or stop putting Jesus first in everything?

Sin marred creation and we all lost our connection to the head. But Ephesians 1:10 explains that through Jesus—God put the head back on! What does the end of verse 10 tell us about Jesus being first?

In this poem, Paul is using the definitions of the Hebrew word "rosh" which means "head" to explain how Jesus is already first. As you read this poem, how is Jesus already first?

Some pracitical ideas for this week:

How can you put Jesus first this week?

Is there anything that you have been adding to Jesus? You don't need it—you just need him! Spend time talking to God about that and letting it go.
