Getting Started  Did you ever feel like you were working as one with a group of people? Perhaps on a team?	What does Paul mean by, "conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel?"
Walking Through the Text—Becoming Aware of AHA moments Read Philippians 1:27-30 Let's spend some time on verse 27. The main verb of this sentence means "to live ones life as a citizen." It is simply translated as "conduct yourself." But the word citizenship has deep significance for the Roman audience of this letter. Citizenship not only entailed rights and privileges for the citizen, but also duties and responsibilities. Why do you think that Paul chose to use this word to describe living or conducting oneself in this passage?	Not only our mouths, but our lives proclaim the gospel. The way we act in public as the church proclaims that Jesus is king; that we have experienced the grace of salvation; that God has saved us. How do our lives proclaim this gospel?
What does it mean to live as a citizen or to conduct oneself? What is he talking about?	What are we proclaiming if we don't live lives worthy of the gospel?
	What did pastor Bob mean by being 360 degree gospel people?
