2015 A new beginning

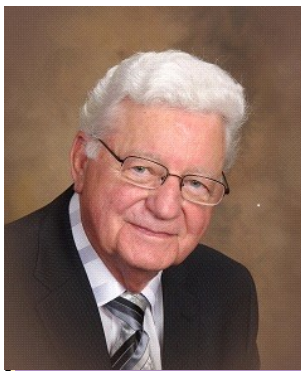
