Placer County – Community Meeting Expectations

Focus: Residents and businesses **without Access** to high speed Internet service (Broadband)

Strategy:

- Discover needs, identify enablers and talk about possible short term improvement possibilities

Objective:

- Provide high speed Internet service (Broadband) to the community within 3-4 months

Meeting Rules:

- Stick to the agenda; understand community needs, educate and adjourn in an hour
- Open, honest and direct dialogue;
- Complete disclosure, transparency and no info-mercials nor public denigration of providers

Meeting Plan:

- **Introductions**
- **Attendee “Call to Action”**
 - Register/Sign-in
 - Identify your location and whether you have Internet service or not (unserved)
 - Unserved attendees complete and hand-in the CPUC Validation Survey or mail it directly to the CPUC. Copies are available from SEDCorp (530.823.4703).
 - Current Internet service subscribers should give provider coverage and speed test feedback directly to the CPUC via www.broadbandmap.ca.gov. Subscribers with an LTE-capable Android Smartphone or tablet can download the CalSPEED Mobile application from the Google Play app store to test their service quality. SEDCorp recommends testing at various times throughout the day and week.
- **Discuss the “Fast-Track” Action Plan & Next Steps**
 - Identify mountain top residents, and perform site surveys and tests.
 - Host a follow-up community meeting in 30-45 days to discuss results, service options and community interest.
