

Dear SPMBC Family and Friends,

In light of the growing concern of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and its potential effects on our gatherings for worship, discipleship and fellowship as well as its overall adverse effects on all of us globally, nationally and locally, SPMBC IS BECOMING A "SANITARY-SENSITIVE" CHURCH BEGINNING MARCH 8, 2020. Being "SANITARY-SENSITIVE" means that we will take steps throughout the day to SANITIZE ourselves as well as provide a SANITARY SPMBC campus as much as humanly possible to protect ourselves and all others with whom we interact from any communicable, contagious, dangerous viruses, bacteria and germs.

Let's Do the Following Actions Relative to Becoming a "SANITARY-SENSITIVE" SPMBC:

 - ✓ In consultation with our Deacons Ministry, we will determine how we will adjust the way we serve the Lord's Supper at our worship service.
 - ✓ Most importantly, if you are contagiously sick with a cold, flu or other illness, please stay at home until you are well. However, please remain connected to SPMBC via SPMBC's social media whenever possible.
