1. REPLACE old thought patterns with new

Begin with victorious scripture: Herb. 12:11, Phil. 4:13, Psalm 1, 23 and 119:9-11, 1 Cor. 10:13



2. REPROGRAM the old thought patterns

by personalizing the word

Use I, me, mine, my as you come across scripture.

- 4 RShow me Your ways, O LORD; Teach me Your paths. Ex. 33:13 Lead me in Your truth and teach
- me.

For You are the God of my salvation;

On You I wait all the day.
