Jesus said, in one of His only specific requests to His disciples. "Pray that the Lord of the harvest will send workers." Someone has written.



Perhaps the greatest Old Testament illustration of this is found in the story of Hannah. From her story we learn these specific keys to prevailing prayer.



I. Prevailing prayer is often preceded by feelings of desperation.

II. Prevailing prayer often produces pain and acts of sacrifice.





III. Prevailing prayer often prepares the way for God's will to be done.
