Romans 2:1-16

There is one sin that you will probably have to deal with more then any other sin in your life. It is so subtle, it often catches us by surprise. Paul clearly identifies this tendency in this section of Romans.

I. No one had the right to Judge others Romans 2:1-3

Definition: "Krino"

It means to condemn and pass verdict without all the facts

4 CHARACTERISTICS OF A SELF-RIGHTEOUS PERSON:

(vs 1) He accuses others and excuses himself

- (vs 2) He measures other people by the wrong standard
- (vs 3) He thinks that judging others put him in a better position.
- (vs 4) He misinterprets God's blessing on his life

WHEN IS IT WRONG TO JUDGE OTHERS?:

Romans 2:1-3 When you practice the same sin

Matthew 7:1-3 When it blinds you to your own faults

John 7:24

Draw conclusions based on outward appearances

John 7:51 When you condemn others without hearing all the facts

Judge others on the basis of the external

observances

When it causes you to 4:11-12 speak evil against or slander, another believer

1 Cor. 4:5 Judge nothing? How is that possible?

II. Only God has the right to judge others Romans 2:6-16
