February 4 is the birthday of Dietrich Bonhoeffer. This German Pastor and teacher has become known as one of the great followers of Christ during the 20th century, who sealed his discipleship with martyrdom on April 9, 1945, when he was executed for his part in the resistance movement against Hitler.

Next month, we enter into the 40 days of Lent (excluding Sundays) from Ash Wednesday (March 6) through Holy Saturday (the day before Easter). During this season, we should do what Bonhoeffer would always do first and foremost: think about Christ. His question, "Wer ist Christus für uns heute (translated "who is Christ for us today?") motivated him throughout his life. From his university lectures on

Christology, through his famous book *Discipleship*, and all the way to his decision to stay in Germany and become involved in the resistance movement, Bonhoeffer was always exploring new ways to relate his faith in God with life in the world around him. "Pray and do what is just" was a common theme throughout his life.

Who really is Christ for us today – what are the challenges and promises in our lives during this day and age? And what should our response be as those who earnestly seek to follow Christ faithfully?

The season of Lent is a purposeful time to cultivate a deeper encounter with Christ. Starting with the Ash Wednesday worship service, give yourself the gift of a closer walk with Christ. Who is Christ for you today?


Radical


Hello again everyone! As we prepare for our youth attending Work Camp in Knoxville, TN the week of July 21-27, 2019 our first fund raiser is approaching.



FAMILY FUSION SMALL GROUP "KINDNESS" STUDY

A major objective of the PPC Family Life Ministry is to provide opportunities for families (especially moms and dads) to connect faith, fellowship and fun. *Family Fusion - Get it?*


SOUP & ROLLS STUDY:
