
CELEBRATING LENT

Join us during this holy season as we focus on, explore and deepen our baptismal spirituality that centers on our union with the Christ.



March begins the Lenten Season with Ash Wednesday on the 6th. Lent is a time set apart to prepare for Easter. The word Lent comes from an Anglo-Saxon word which means "to lengthen" and is associated with the lengthening of days in the spring. For the first two centuries of Christianity, the period of preparation for Easter was only 40 hours in remembrance of the time Jesus spent in the tomb.

In the third century, this was extended to six days. And in 325 A.D. the season was extended to 40 days. By the eighth century, Ash Wednesday was recognized as the beginning of Lent. Ash Wednesday derives its name from Old Testament times when sackcloth and ashes were used as symbols of repentance. Lent is a season of discipline,

reflection and getting closer to God. I encourage you to actively plan for Lent.

- Take advantage of this time in the church year to deepen your relationship with God, your neighbors and yourself.
- Sunday morning meditation gives you a chance to be still and listen for God's calling in your life.
- Attend the five Soup & Rolls dinners and studies that are planned.
- Live out the virtue of hospitality, welcoming others to church so that they may come to God in more meaningful ways.
- Spend time daily in a devotional of your choosing followed by prayer.
- Attend Sunday Discipleship classes that will enjoy "Eternity is Now in Session" by John Ortberg.

Lent is a beautiful time in the church year. It's the season to recommit ourselves to a life of faith, to examine our life and lifestyles and assess the strength of our commitment to God, to repent as we acknowledge that we've turned our hearts from God, and to adopt spiritual disciplines that draw us closer to God. Most importantly, Lent is a season of action. Do something for Lent! I pray that the season will bring you closer to God, your neighbors and yourself.



Providence Presbyterian Church (PPC) has a parttime staff position available to work 30 hours a week starting May 1, 2019.



FAMILY FUSION "KINDNESS" STUDY

A major objective of the PPC Family Life Ministry is to provide opportunities for families (especially moms and dads) to connect faith, fellowship and fun. Family Fusion - Get it?

We strongly believe that when families (or sometimes "just couples") make time for what's most important, everything changes! Lives become less stressful, relationships grow and Christ's Community strengthens.

In an effort to help couples strengthen their marriage and relationship, we started a six-session small group study focused on *kindness* in January. We meet every other week (March 3 and March 17) in the church's Media Room. We spend one hour sharing a meal, study and conversation. 
