Rise Against Hunger - Rise against hunger – On October 1 our congregation will participate in a meal packaging event in conjunction with Rise Against Hunger Inc., a group whose mission is growing a global movement to end world hunger by empowering communities, nourishing lives, and responding to emergencies. This event is designed to allow participation by everyone age 4 and over. We will turn the fellowship hall into our production area for a few hours and the end result will be 10,000 dehydrated, shelf-stable meals that will be transported by rise Against Hunger to identified areas of food insecurity throughout the world.
