# Year 1 Recap

One year ago SowingRoots was a dream. It literally kept me awake for nights on end. We were in the middle of our family's own personal adoption journey and yet what kept me awake was the idea that there was something more. There was something more for these children who need families. There was something more for these families longing and aching to fill their homes with children who are vulnerable and without. And the reality is that money should not be the inhibitor of a very able family bringing home a child in need.

That's what would wake me up, night after night. And then it became clear. We were supposed to do something. That's where SowingRoots was conceived - the idea that we can do more. We can band together and support each other and support those we don't know in order that families can be united forever. And bigger than that the vision was that for each child brought together with a family SowingRoots would also bless that orphanage or foster home with some sort of sustainable gift. Simply put, that the children left behind would be blessed with something lasting, something that could make life a little better for them.

We set out to award 5 families grants in 2013. So, now one year later we are proud to report that we have met and exceeded that goal! Because of the generous donations of donors and people surrounding us and believing in the mission we have also been able to bless a number of orphanages around the world with some tangible needs.

This past year has shown us that SowingRoots does have a place in the adoption community as well as the orphan care community as a whole. We are actively seeking partnerships so that we can continue to do more and expand our reach. We hope that the next 12 months prove to be full of impacting others in a way that is life altering. We can only accomplish this by partnering with people who realize that by saying "yes" they too can make a difference in the life of a child and forever family. ### Running Campaign

In April Nate ran the Boston Marathon in honor of his son and raising funds for SowingRoots. The SowingRoots running campaign raised over \$1000 towards the mission of helping adoptive families.



### **Donations**

In May SowingRoots was able to donate 22 mosquito nets to an orphanage in need in DR Congo. Malaria kills some 400 children a day in this country — an often preventable disease that kills too many. Along with mosquito nets this orphanage received 15 mattresses, malaria test kits, beans, rice and powdered milk.

## Being a Blessing

May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013 SowingRoots hosted its first launch event in Tacoma, WA. We were able to express the mission and vision behind SowingRoots to a room of about 100 people. We were blown away by the generosity of those in the room. We were able to raise over \$20,000 that night.

One of the special things SowingRoots did that night was to make each part of the event something that "worked" towards the goal of caring for orphans. With that, the centerpieces were different sized, cute, brightly colored shoes. Each of these pairs of shoes was then donated to an orphanage in Honduras where we've created some relationships through other adoptive families



and missionaries. In July, these shoes were delivered to a thankful staff and children at that Honduras orphanage.

### A story from Ethiopia

In October SowingRoots was able to partner with YWAM and meet the tangible need of a remarkable young man who grew up in Ethiopia with no family to call his own. Not only no family, but now this young man, Kalieb has aged out of the system and has to leave the orphanage. This remarkable young man has survived the system in Ethiopia and has thrived by pursuing the education that was put before him and surpassing everyone's expectations. When teachers didn't show up to class, he would stand in and teach. And for years continued to pass test after test and remain at the top of the class blowing everyone away and graduating with honors. Kalieb just came up on the time for national exams in Ethiopia. As in most Aftican countries this exam decides if and how strong of a university you will attend. He pressed on with no help, no tutors, no

mom and dad encourage him. Well our new friend Kaleib was the top scorer in all of Ethiopia. What does this mean for Kalieb? It means he now is admitted to university if and only if he can find a laptop. Really, a child who raises himself, never asks for help as an orphan is going to not go to university because of computer. SowingRoots thought this was silly too. So because of your faithful donations, SowingRoots was able to provide Kaleib (who undoubtedly will change the world in time) with a computer. In fact he already has, he just doesn't know it yet. This is the impact SowingRoots is having around the world, one life at a time.
