## Lies From the Past that Cripple Us Today:

> Your life will (always) be like this.

Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" "From childhood," he answered. – Mark 9:21-22

> No one can really help you.

## **Embracing Hope for a Brighter Future:**

3. You must trust in (God's power) to change you.
